Teacher Certificate Program

The Felician College Cost of Attendance is an estimate of a student's educational expenses for a period of enrollment. Federal law dictates the types of expenses that can be included in a Cost of Attendance. Regulations allow schools to set the allowances used for each type of cost and create a Cost of Attendance for different categories of students.
