

ACADEMIC BRIDGE PROGRAM: ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL)

Felician's ESL Academic Bridge Program is available to international students who are academically admissible to one of our undergraduate or graduate degree programs but do not meet our minimum English language requirements.

The ESL Academic Bridge Program requires one to four semesters of intensive English language preparation. Once all ESL requirements are met, you seamlessly transition into your degree program.

We want to make the admission process as simple as possible for you.

DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION

For fall semester- apply by June 1

For spring semester- apply by December 1

TEST SCORES:

If your native language is not English, you will need to submit a qualifying test of English score report.* We accept any one of the following exams:

TOEFL IBT	61	79
Paper- Based TOEFL	500	550
IELTS	5.5	6.5
Other	400 on SAT CR	N/A

^{*}Students who do not meet our minimum English language requirements may apply to Felician's English as a Second Language (ESL) Academic Bridge Program.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

International Scholarship: \$10,000 - \$15,000 per year

- You must take the SAT to qualify.
- You must score at least a 900 on the Math and Critical Reading scores on the SAT.
- You must have the equivalent to a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

International Award: \$5,000 - \$10,000 per year

- No SAT scores required.
- Award is determined by a holistic review of your application and qualifications.

International Transfer Scholarship: \$4,500 - \$15,000

- You must have more than 12 credits of earned university credit (foreign or domestic).
- You must have at least a 2.5 GPA in your university work.
- Award is determined by a holistic review of your application and credentials.



UNDERGRADUATE REQUIREMENTS

- A completed online application form: www.felician.edu/ apply or submit the Common Application with essay/ personal statement online at www.commonapp.org
- Official copies of secondary school transcripts in English and/or official copies of all post-secondary transcripts in English if you have completed any university work
- All nursing transfer students are required to submit a credential evaluation of any foreign university work upon application. All other transfer applicants are required to submit a credential evaluation once admitted to the college. We accept any service that are members of NACES (www.naces.org)
- A personal statement
- \$30 application fee
- English Proficiency Exam (see chart)
- SAT/ACT scores for first time freshmen, if available. These
 tests are not required for undergraduate admission unless
 you are applying for the Nursing program. We do highly
 recommend that these test scores are submitted in order
 to qualify for higher scholarship awards
- Copy of passport information page
- Financial certifications and agreement of financial support, if applying for an F1 student visa
